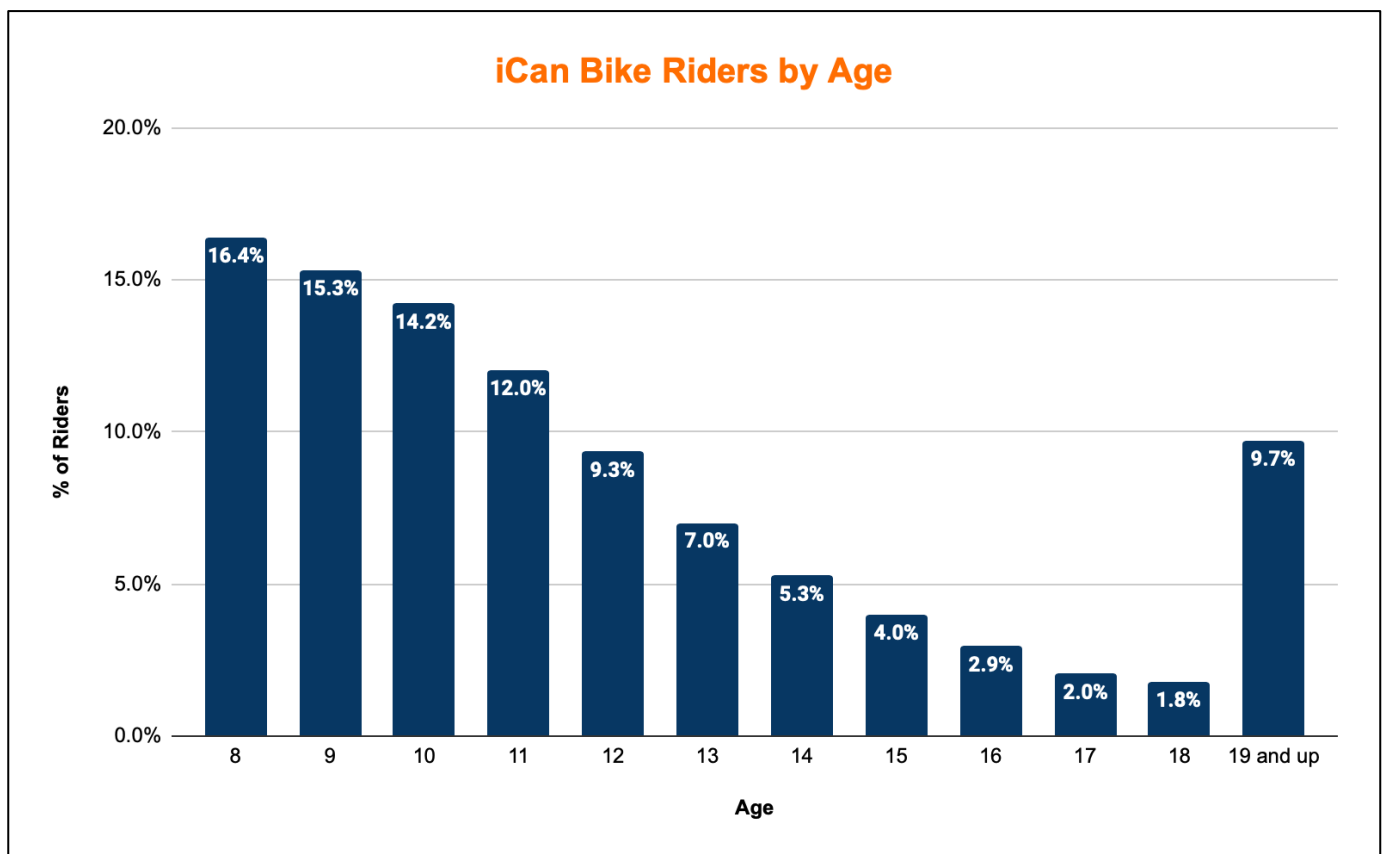
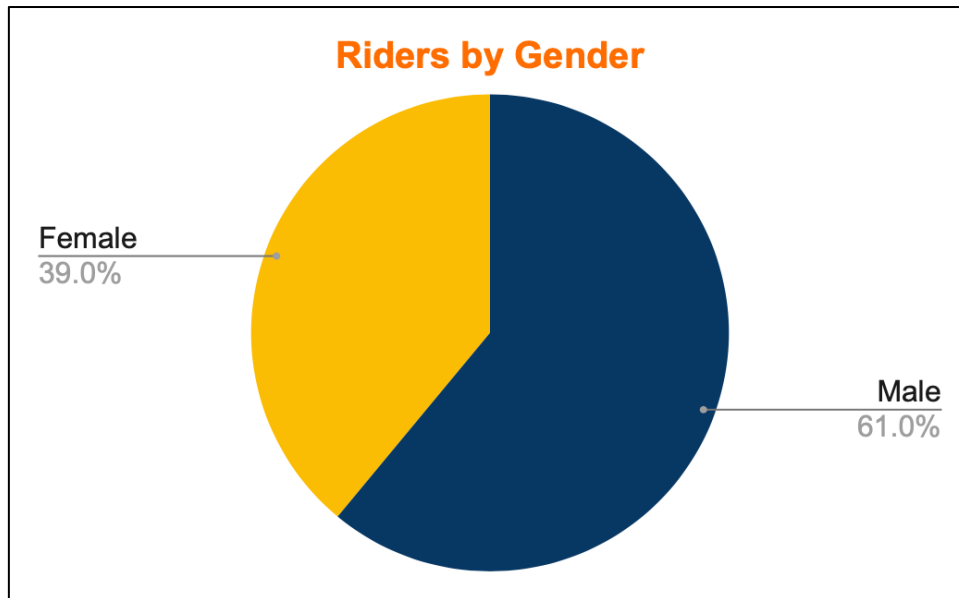


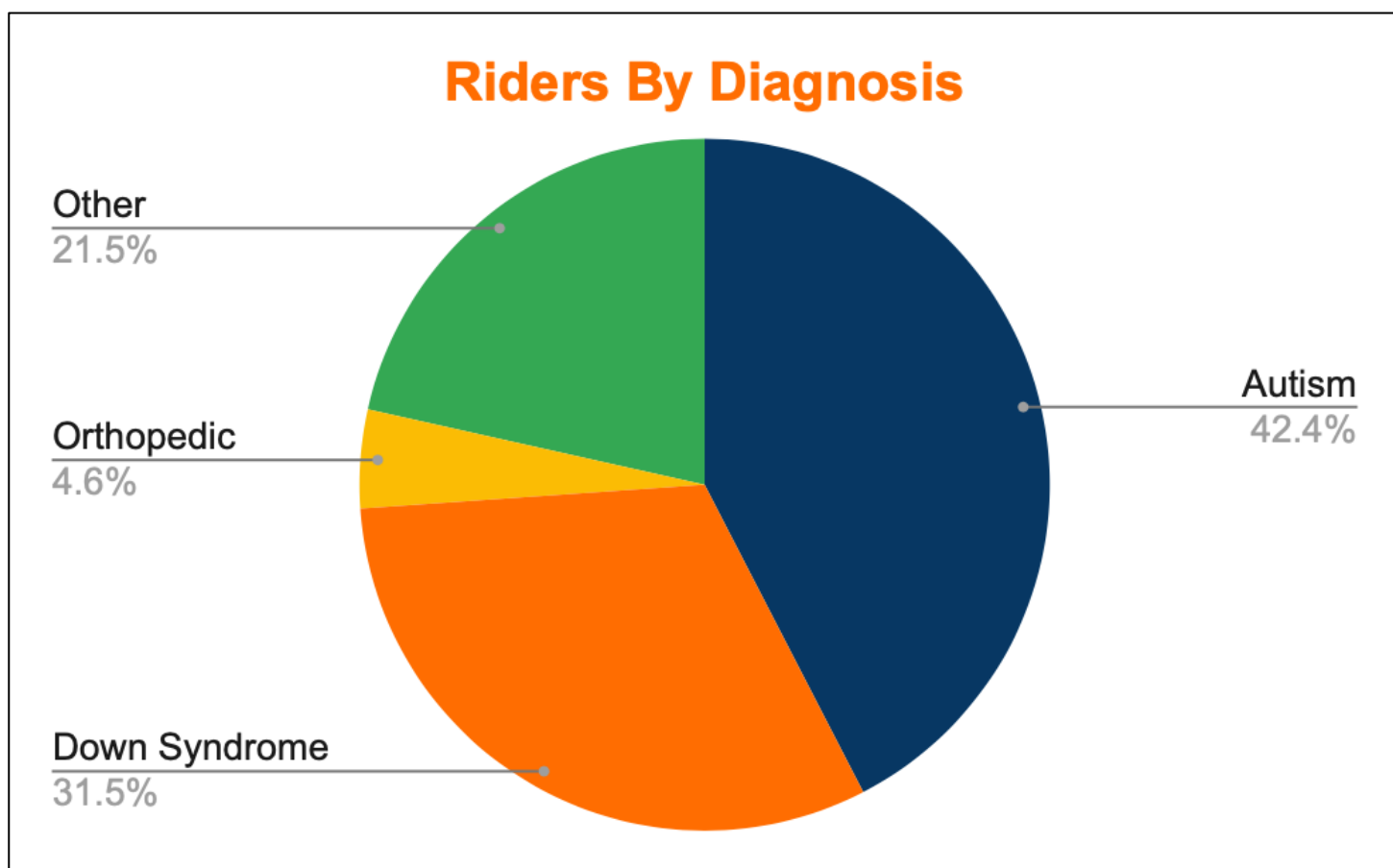


The data utilized to prepare this report was collected from our 2018-2023 iCan Bike camps.



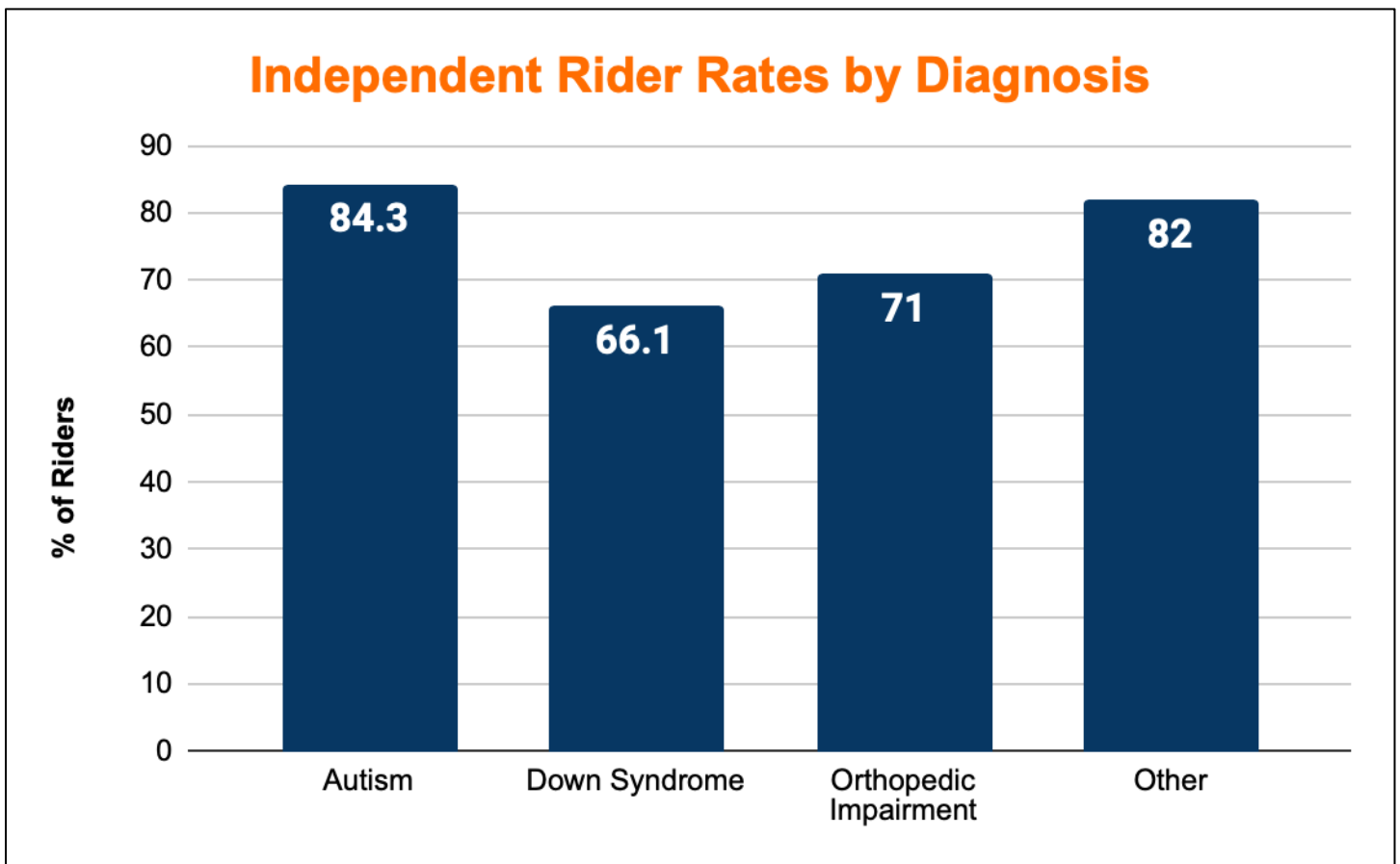
iCan Shine collects a Primary and Secondary Diagnosis (if applicable) for all riders. All references to diagnosis below relate only to the Primary Diagnosis. In addition to the two main disabilities we serve, of Autism and Down Syndrome, the remaining disabilities data were allocated to:

- Orthopedic primarily includes Cerebral Palsy, Hemiparesis and Hemiplegia
- Other primarily includes Intellectual/developmental delays, ADD, ADHD, other chromosomal diagnoses, brain injuries and visual impairments

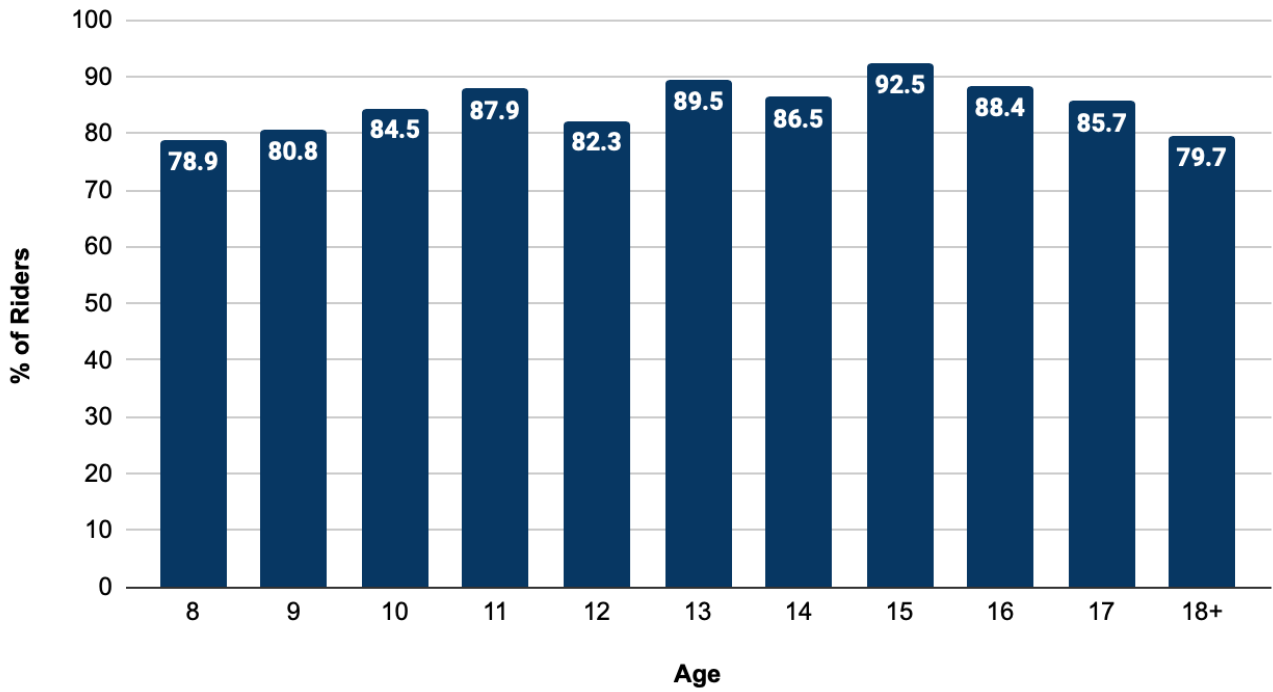


Independent Rider Statistics

For the purpose of data collection and analysis we define an 'independent rider' as being able to ride a conventional two-wheel bicycle 75 feet continuously and unassisted (every 2 out of 3 times) during the last day of our 5-day iCan Bike program. Riders who do not participate for at least 80% of our 5-day program, typically due to absence or noncompliance, are excluded from this data.
